1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to prohibit age discrimination in the workplace.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 Section 1. That § 20-13-10 be amended to read as follows:

4 20-13-10. It is an unfair or discriminatory practice for any person, because of race, color,
5 creed, religion, sex, ancestry, age, disability, or national origin, to fail or refuse to hire, to
6 discharge an employee, or to accord adverse or unequal treatment to any person or employee
7 with respect to application, hiring, training, apprenticeship, tenure, promotion, upgrading,
8 compensation, layoff, or any term or condition of employment.

9 Section 2. That chapter 20-13 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
10 follows:

11 For the purpose of this section, age is defined as the attainment by any person of at least forty
12 years of age.
