- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to limit the damages that may be awarded in a medical
- 2 malpractice action against an optometrist.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 21-3-11 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 21-3-11. In any action for damages for personal injury or death alleging malpractice against
- 6 any physician licensed pursuant to chapter 36-4, chiropractor, optometrist, dentist, dental
- 7 hygienist, dental assistant, hospital, critical access hospital, registered nurse, licensed practical
- 8 nurse, certified registered nurse anesthetist, clinical nurse specialist, nurse practitioner, nurse
- 9 midwife, or physician's assistant, or against the practitioner's corporate, limited liability
- 10 partnership, or limited liability company employer based upon the acts or omissions of the
- practitioner, under the laws of this state, whether taken through the court system or by binding
- arbitration, the total general damages which may be awarded may not exceed the sum of five
- hundred thousand dollars. There is no limitation on the amount of special damages which may
- be awarded. This section applies only to causes of action arising from injuries or death occurring
- after July 1, 1976. However, in the case of chiropractors, it applies only to the causes of action

- 1 arising from injuries or death occurring after July 1, 1978. <u>In the case of optometrists, it applies</u>
- 2 only to causes of action arising from injuries or death occurring after July 1, 2002.
