1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to exempt certain school districts from certain reductions 2 in state aid to education. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA: 4 Section 1. For the purposes of this Act a reorganized school district is a school district that 5 has reorganized under the provisions of chapter 13-6, exclusive of minor boundary changes. 6 Section 2. That § 13-13-73.2 be amended to read as follows: 7 13-13-73.2. A school district's state aid for general education as calculated pursuant to 8 § 13-13-73 shall be reduced by the following calculation: 9 (1) Subtract the allowable general fund balance from the general fund balance. If the 10 result is less than zero, (1) equals zero; 11 (2) Determine the lower of the general fund base percentage or the general fund balance 12 percentage; 13 (3) Subtract twenty percent (0.2) from the result of (2). If the result is less than zero, (3) 14 equals zero; 15 (4) Multiply the result of (3) by the district's general fund expenditures in the previous

- 1 school fiscal year;
- 2 (5) Multiply the result of (4) by the imputed interest rate;
- 3 (6) Add the result of (1) and the result of (5).
- 4 This section does not apply to a school district that has reorganized for a period of four years
- 5 <u>after the reorganization.</u>
- 6 Section 3. The Department of Education and Cultural Affairs may promulgate rules pursuant
- 7 to chapter 1-16 to define a reorganization resulting from a minor boundary change.
