- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to require the use of ethanol fuel in certain state vehicles.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 Section 1. Beginning January 1, 2003, any gasoline-powered motor vehicle that is owned or
- 4 leased by the state may only be fueled with ethanol blend fuel as defined in § 10-47B-3. Each
- 5 state-owned fuel terminal or facility for fueling state vehicles shall provide a supply of ethanol
- 6 blend fuel in quantities sufficient to meet normal fueling needs at the terminal facility.
