That § 58-33-67 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SUBDIVISION to read 10 as follows: 11 Excluding medical benefits under health care coverage subject to Title 58 to any covered 12 person based solely on that person's casual or nonprofessional participation in the following

activities: motorcycling, snowmobiling, or off-highway vehicle riding.
