SENATE BILL NO. 163

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to prohibit discrimination by health insurers against
2 individuals who participate in certain activities.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 58-33-67 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SUBDIVISION to read
5 as follows:

6 Denying health care coverage subject to Title 58 to any person based solely on that person's
7 casual or nonprofessional participation in the following activities: motorcycling, snowmobiling,
8 or off-highway vehicle riding.

9 Section 2. That § 58-33-67 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SUBDIVISION to read
10 as follows:

11 Excluding medical benefits under health care coverage subject to Title 58 to any covered
12 person based solely on that person's casual or nonprofessional participation in the following
13 activities: motorcycling, snowmobiling, or off-highway vehicle riding.
