SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 9

1	A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION, Designating "Yesterday's Tomorrows" in the city of Pierre.
2	WHEREAS, South Dakota has been and continues to be home to any number of industrious
3	and innovative people who have thought about our state's future; and
4	WHEREAS, the Smithsonian Institution's "Museum on Main Street" program offers a
5	portable exhibition that looks at finding the future in the media, the design of homes, methods
6	of transportation, and community planning; and
7	WHEREAS, the South Dakota Humanities Council selected seven South Dakota
8	communities to host the exhibition in 2002; and
9	WHEREAS, each of these communities will examine and celebrate the ways in which their
10	residents over the years have envisioned the future through auxiliary displays and events during
11	their hosting which will involve countless numbers of visitors and residents; and
12	WHEREAS, the city of Pierre is one of those communities on the tour:
13	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Senate of the Seventy-seventh Legislature
14	of the State of South Dakota, the House of Representatives concurring therein, that
15	November 25 - December 29, 2002, be named "Yesterday's Tomorrows" in the city of Pierre.
