MARIJUANA INTERIM STUDY COMMITTEE TO MEET

PIERRE –The Marijuana Interim Study Committee will hold their second meeting of the 2021 interim on Wednesday, October 27, 2021, at 8:30 a.m. (CT). The meeting is being conducted via electronic conference and in Room 414 of the State Capitol in Pierre, South Dakota, to allow for both remote and in-person participation.
