<u>Department of Agriculture and Natural Resources:</u> (September 23, 2022) intends to amend rules to update South Dakota's existing industrial hemp rules to meet the requirements in current federal regulations and state laws. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the department, is SDCL 38-35-11.
