Department of Agriculture and Natural Resources: (July 11, 2023) intends to adopt a rule to adopt the model bill and regulations regarding labeling recommendations from the most current Official Publication of the Association of American Feed Control Officials. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the department, is SDCL 39-14-60.

Department of Public Safety: (July 11, 2023) intends to amend rules to adopt the 2021 editions of the National Board Inspection Code handbook and American Society of Mechanical Engineers Boiler and Pressure Vessel Code handbook, and the 2023 edition of the Commercial Vehicle Safety Alliance handbook; revise rules pertaining to motorcycle safety education courses; and adopt current policy and procedure for the issuance of burn permits. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the department, is SDCL 32-12A-48, 32-20-14, 34-29A-14.1, 34-29A-16, 34-35-19, and 49-28A-2.
