Department of Health: (February 26, 2024) intends to amend a rule to correct language to clarify that home health agency personnel and hospice providers are required to be Medicare-certified, not Medicaid-certified. The general authority for this rule, as cited by the department, is SDCL [34-12-7](#) and [34-12-13](#).

A public hearing will be held at the Hayes Building Conference Room, 600 East Capitol Avenue, Pierre, South Dakota, on March 25, 2024, at 1:00 p.m. (CT). Copies of the proposed rule may be obtained without charge from, and written comments may be sent to, the Department of Health, Office of Licensure and Certification, 600 East Capitol Avenue, Pierre, South Dakota 57501 or <http://rules.sd.gov>. Material sent by mail must reach the Department of Health by April 4, 2024, to be considered. Those wishing to testify remotely must register by March 22, 2024, by email to DOHAdminRules@state.sd.us. Witnesses should provide their full name, email address, whom they are representing, and city of residence. This hearing is being held in a physically accessible location.
