**South Dakota Secretary of State:** (May 10, 2024) intends to amend rules to add e-notary to the current notary public form and modify the oath to better conform to other oaths currently in use. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the office, is SDCL [18-1-1](#) and [18-1-11.7](#).

A public hearing at which persons may present amendments, data, opinions, and arguments for or against the proposed rules will be held at the South Dakota Capitol Building, Room 362, 500 East Capitol Avenue, Pierre, South Dakota, on June 11, 2024, at 1:30 p.m. (CT). ### Executive Orders

---

Governor Noem has signed [Executive Order 2024-03](#), dated May 2, 2024, reaffirming that the South Dakota Hazard Mitigation Team created in 2019 be maintained and authorized to function in response to future natural disasters in South Dakota. The purpose of the Order, as described in the document, is to designate the state departments and offices from which individuals will be selected to form the core leadership of the South Dakota Hazard Mitigation Team; specify that the director of the South Dakota Office of Emergency Management will serve as chairperson of the Team with that entity serving as the coordinating office for the Team; and outline the Team's specific duties and responsibilities, including the implementation of a statewide Hazard Mitigation Program based upon § 404 of the [Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and](#)

[Emergency Assistance Act \(Public Law 93-288\)](#), as amended. The Order supersedes [Executive Order 2019-29](#), dated December 10, 2019. This latest Order states that the South Dakota Hazard Mitigation Team will not dissolve until the Order is rescinded or superseded.

<b>5-20-2024</b>	<b><a href="#">South Dakota Board of Education Standards (Department of Education)</a></b> : Amend rules to remove the youth suicide awareness and prevention training requirement from the certification process; 50 SDR 132, May 6, 2024.
<b>5-23-2024</b>	<b><a href="#">Department of Transportation</a></b> : Amend rules to change speed limits on State Trunk Highway 87, U.S. Highway 16, and State Trunk Highway 40 in Pennington County; on U.S. Highway 14 and 14B in Brookings County; on State Trunk Highway 34, State Trunk Highway 79, and U.S. Highway 212 in Butte County; on U.S. Highway 16A, State Trunk Highway 87, State Trunk Highway 89, and U.S. Highway 385 in Custer County; on U.S. Highway 212 and the Interstate 90 eastbound off ramp into the Tilford port of entry in Meade County; and on State Trunk Highway 20 in Perkins County. The proposed rules will also eliminate duplication and make stylistic changes; 50 SDR 133, May 6, 2024.
<b>5-31-2024</b>	<b><a href="#">South Dakota State Board of Dentistry (Department of Health)</a></b> : Amend rules to update the collaborative supervision administrative rules and remove a clinical practice requirement to make the rules consistent with <a href="#">House Bill 1074</a> , which was passed by the 2024 Legislature; 50 SDR 118, April 8, 2024.
<b>6-5-2024</b>	<b><a href="#">South Dakota Board of Nursing (Department of Health)</a></b> : Adopt and amend rules to revise the approval process for clinical enrichment programs and use of nurse preceptors, add requirements for nurses and registrants to report to the board within 60 days a new address, name, or other reportable event; 50 SDR 132, May 6, 2024.
<b>6-11-2024</b>	<b><a href="#">South Dakota Secretary of State</a></b> : Amend rules to add e-notary to the current notary public form and modify the oath to better conform to other oaths currently in use; 50 SDR 135, May 13, 2024.
<b>7-8-2024</b>	<b><a href="#">South Dakota Board of Education Standards (Department of Education)</a></b> : Amend rules to align with the appeal window in codified law and make updates for consistent reference to due process complaints and the 30-day resolution period; 50 SDR 128, April 29, 2024.
