## Notice of Holiday Hours

The Legislative Research Council office will be closed Monday, September 2, 2024, for the Labor Day holiday. The office reopens for regular business hours at 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, September 3, 2024.

#### **Notice**

The **Department of Social Services** intends to amend the South Dakota CHIP State Plan regarding substitution of coverage. As required by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) April 2, 2024, final rule (CMS-2421-FS) to remove barriers to children's coverage, the proposed state plan amendment (SPA) removes the ninety-day waiting period prior to CHIP enrollment for substitution of coverage. The SPA amends the CHIP Plan Eligibility template pages CS20: Non-Financial Eligibility - Substitution of Coverage.

The department intends to make this SPA effective July 1, 2024, and estimates there will be no fiscal impact in Federal Fiscal Year 2024 and Federal Fiscal Year 2025 as the State has historically not needed to impose the enrollment waiting period.

# **SCHEDULED PUBLIC HEARINGS**

South Dakota Electrical Commission (Department of Labor and Regulation): Amend rules to adopt
the 2023 National Electrical Code (NEC); implement standards for the approval and management of
third-party inspectors; apply the statutory minimum inspection fee of one hundred dollars under
SDCL 36-16-30; and formalize the third-party inspector process; 50 SDR 142, May 28, 2024.
Department of Game, Fish and Parks: Amend rules to cap the number of nonresident turkey licenses
in the Black Hills; modify the statewide Archery Spring turkey hunting units; modify the existing fish
harvest regulations on Belle Fourche Reservoir; modify snagging on Lake Oahe; modify bobcat
trapping and hunting; modify scientific names for certain species of crayfish to reflect updates in
