South Dakota Lottery Commission (Department of Revenue): (September 9, 2024) intends to amend rules to allow for mobile claims, a process by which players may use a mobile device to determine if they have a winning ticket, and to claim the prize thereof between \$101 and \$5,000; clarify existing duties of the Executive Director of the South Dakota Lottery; and reflect changes to the Mega Millions product group rules adopted by the Multi State Lottery Association. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the commission, is SDCL 42-7A-4, 42-7A-11, and 42-7A-21.

<u>South Dakota State Brand Board (Department of Agriculture and Natural Resources):</u> (September 10, 2024) intends to amend rules to change the Lifetime Travel Permit fee on horses and update laws implemented to current state statutes. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the board, is SDCL 40-18-16.
