Executive Order

Governor Noem has signed [Executive Order 2024-07](#), dated November 25, 2024, establishing required state employee training covering "legal and ethical standards related to conflict of interest, public trust, duty to act, controls, and service to citizens." The purpose of the Order, as described in the document, is to direct "that all state employees and supervisors of executive branch agencies controlled by the Governor be regularly informed of and adhere to their legal and ethical obligations regarding the proper use of public funds." The Commissioner of the Bureau of Human Resources and Administration is tasked with developing and conducting the training program. State employees and supervisors will be required to take the training annually, while new employees will be required to complete the training within the first thirty days of employment. The Order goes into effect immediately and does not have an expiration date.
