Notice of Proposed Rules

**Board of Barber Examiners (Department of Labor and Regulation):** (March 11, 2025) intends to amend rules to revise the renewal date for a barber school license; increase fees for barber certificate renewal, barber certificate restoration, barber certificate restoration annual penalty, barber school license, barbershop license (initial and renewal), and barber chair license (initial and renewal); and establish new fee rules for fees related to annual inspections and initial barber licensure. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the department, is SDCL <u>36-14-9</u>, <u>36-14-24</u>, <u>36-14-27</u>, and <u>36-14-30</u>.

Department of Game, Fish and Parks: (March 14, 2025) intends to adopt, amend, or repeal rules to clarify the use of personal flotation devises; ensure that required fire extinguishers on boats operated in public waters are in serviceable condition and not expired; include PRE-09A and PRE-27A in Prairie Elk Hunting Season units eligible for a landowner-own-land resident-only antlerless elk license; remove the reference to a locking seal requirement for Canada geese; increase the daily limit of pintail ducks and reduce the bonus blue-winged teal season to nine days; modify the season dates in Unit 3 to match the season dates in Unit 2 for Canada geese; allow hunting in CGW-11A with an appropriate waterfowl license without the requirement to obtain a permit specific to Bennett County; remove language describing bag limits, permit requirements, and the application process for CGW-11A Special Canada Goose; move twenty-five nonresident licenses from NRW-11A to NRW-00B; preclude ARSD 41:06:50:02 from referencing Unit 3; expand the unit boundary for BHS-BH4 and clean up unit descriptions; expand PRE-09A and PRE-27A season dates; expand PRE-WRA; and allow the initiation of the pursuit of a mountain lion with dogs outside the Black Hills Fire Protection District to occur anywhere. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the department, is SDCL <u>32-3A-1</u>, <u>41-2-18</u>, <u>41-6-18.4</u>, <u>41-6-19.3</u>, <u>41-6-19.4</u>, <u>41-6-19.9</u>, <u>41-6-19.9</u>, <u>41-6-19.5</u>.

A public hearing at which persons may present amendments, data, opinions, and arguments for or against the proposed rules will be held at the Matthews Training Center, 523 East Capitol Avenue, Pierre, South Dakota, on April 3, 2025, at 2:00 p.m. (CT). **Department of Social Services:** (March 14, 2025) intends to update adoption rules specific to kinship adoptions and to create a new foster licensure pathway for kinship foster homes. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the department, is SDCL <u>26-4-9.1</u> and <u>26-6-16</u>.

A public hearing at which persons may present amendments, data, opinions, and arguments for or against the proposed rules will be held at the Department of Social Services Building, Linden Conference Room C207, 1501 South Highline Avenue, Sioux Falls, South Dakota, on April 14, 2025, at 11:00 a.m. (CT). #### Notice

The **Department of Social Services** intends to make changes to the clinic services section of the South Dakota Medicaid State Plan. Clinic services are a specific benefit type, distinct from physician services, which generally only permit services inside a physical building. Providers included in the clinic benefit include ambulatory surgical centers, renal dialysis clinics, Indian Health Service (IHS) clinics, and Department of Health clinics. On November 27, 2024, Centers for Medicare and Medicaid (CMS) published a final rule clarifying coverage of clinic services furnished outside the clinic as allowable in certain circumstances under 42 CFR 440.90. CMS is requiring states to submit a state plan amendment (SPA) to incorporate attestation pages to indicate the state is in compliance with this federal regulation.

These proposed SPA pages provide assurances that South Dakota Medicaid covers clinic services furnished outside the clinic to an eligible individual who does not reside in a permanent dwelling or does not have a fixed home or mailing address; and outside a clinic operated by the IHS or by a Tribe or Tribal organization by clinic personnel under the direction of a physician.

The SPA has an effective date of January 1, 2025, and adds template pages 15a-15f to Supplement to Attachment 3.1-A of the Medicaid State Plan. The department estimates there will be no fiscal impact associated with this SPA in Federal Fiscal Year 2025 and Federal Fiscal Year 2026 as coverage was formerly permitted by CMS as a COVID-19 public health emergency exception that was extended through February 11, 2025.
