Petition for Rules

The **Department of Game, Fish and Parks** on March 20, 2025, served on the Interim Rules Review Committee and the director of the Legislative Research Council, a petition received from an interested person, per <u>SDCL 1-26-13</u>, to amend ARSD <u>41:07:02:01</u> to eliminate the closed area on Lake Francis Case. The <u>Game, Fish and Parks Commission</u> is scheduled to review the petition at its April 3, 2025, meeting.

Notice

The **Department of Social Services** intends to update the South Dakota Medicaid State Plan to clarify provider screening and enrollment processes. The proposed state plan amendment (SPA) adds the current process used to determine if it is appropriate to approve an enrollment with a retroactive billing eligibility date. The state plan is being updated based on recent Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services guidance that this information should be included in the Medicaid State Plan.

The SPA has an effective date of April 1, 2025, and supersedes pages 79ad-79ae of Section 4.46 of the Medicaid State Plan. The department estimates there will be no fiscal impact associated with this SPA in Federal Fiscal Year 2025 and Federal Fiscal Year 2026 as the amendment allows for alignment with current practice.
