# Notice of Proposed Rules

<u>South Dakota Division of Insurance (Department of Labor and Regulation):</u> (March 24, 2025) intends to amend rules to incorporate the 2025 Medicare Supplement coverage amounts set by the federal government. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the division, is SDCL 58-17A-2 and 58-17A-5.

### **Executive Order**

Governor Rhoden has signed Executive Order 2025-02 establishing the South Dakota Commission on Child Support. The Order, dated March 21, 2025, directs the Commission to review the child support obligation laws as required by SDCL 25-7-6.12 and related sections, and submit a report to the Governor and Legislature by December 31, 2025. Membership of the Commission is to be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the Governor, and must include one or more representatives from the following areas: payor of support; receiver of support; the South Dakota Judiciary; the South Dakota Department of Social Services; a family law attorney who is a member in good standing of the South Dakota State Bar; a child support referee; a member of the South Dakota Senate; and a member of the South Dakota House of Representatives. The South Dakota Commission on Child Support will be administered by the Department of Social Services and will be dissolved upon completion of its report. The Order expires upon submission of the report but no later than December 31, 2025.
