9-23-2025	<u>South Dakota Transportation Commission (Department of Transportation):</u> Amend rules to, in Beadle County, extend the current forty-five mile per hour speed limit on U.S. Highway 14 on the south edge of Wolsey and the current forty-five mile per hour speed limit on Highway 37 in Huron; in Lawrence County, add a forty-five mile per hour transition speed zone on U.S. Highway 14A and U.S. Highway 85 at and around Cheyenne Crossing and eliminate a truck speed limit on U.S. Highway 14A east of Cheyenne Crossing; in Fall River County, extend a fifty-five mile per hour speed zone on State Trunk Highway 79 and correct minor deviations in speed zone distances; for Hamlin County, extend the current twenty-five mile per hour speed zone on State Trunk Highway 21 on the east edge of Hayti; for Hanson County, lengthen the existing forty-five mile per hour speed zone at the I-90 interchange on State Trunk Highway 262 and correct naming conventions; for Jones County, add a forty-five mile per hour transition speed zone on U.S. Highway 83 in and around Murdo; and for rules throughout, eliminate redundancy by clarifying the starting and ending points for speed zones and revising speed zone measurements to the nearest one-tenth of a mile; 52 SDR 26, September 2, 2025.
9-25-2025	<u>South Dakota Lottery Commission (Department of Revenue):</u> Adopt rules for the introduction and operation of the Millionaire for Life lotto game, as it replaces the Lucky for Life lotto game; 52 SDR 23, August 25, 2025.
9-26-2025	<u>South Dakota Plumbing Commission (Department of Labor and Regulation):</u> Amend rules to adopt the 2024 Uniform Plumbing Code and amendments; 52 SDR 30, September 8, 2025.
