Notices

The **Department of Social Services** intends to make changes to the South Dakota CHIP State Plan to provide federally required assurances regarding the eligibility of Targeted Low-Income Children (TLIC) who are or become incarcerated. The proposed State Plan Amendment (SPA) provides assurances that the State is in compliance with the juvenile justice federal requirements in Section 5121 of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2023.

The SPA adds CS31 - Incarcerated CHIP Beneficiaries template pages to the CHIP State Plan. The department intends to make this SPA effective July 1, 2025, and advises that the fiscal impact associated with this SPA is included in the previous projections for the CHIP Juvenile Justice SPA #25-004. Those estimates were \$16,897 in state funds and \$23,868 in federal funds, totaling \$40,765 in Federal Fiscal Year 2026, and \$16,897 in state funds and \$23,868 in federal funds, totaling \$40,765 in Federal Fiscal Year 2027.

The public comment period will start December 15, 2025, and end January 14, 2026.

12-16-2025	<u>South Dakota Commission on Gaming (Department of Revenue):</u> Adopt a rule to offer a variation of play and corresponding pay table for a new poker game called Heads Up Hold 'Em; 52 SDR 54, November 17, 2025.
12-16-2025	<u>South Dakota Commission on Gaming (Department of Revenue):</u> Amend and adopt rules to develop and administer a self-exclusion plan for individuals who want to be excluded from participating in gaming; update technical standards to reference the most recent version available; update reporting requirements to be in line with the Internal Revenue Service; clarify access to the cashier's cage in a gaming establishment; correct pay table information for the Cover All Bonus game; prohibit the use of counting and recording devices within a gaming establishment; clarify what products constitute parts for the maintenance of slot machines; clarify the amounts of abandoned credits and payouts for which licensees must conduct investigations to return abandoned tokens, cash, or chips; update W-2G references in the Gaming Internal Control and Revenue Reporting Manual to correspond with the amounts mandated by the Internal Revenue Service; and repeal rules relating to drop buckets on slot machines, and the duties and termination of qualifying licensees, managers, and agents; 52 SDR 54, November 17, 2025.
