Department of Game, Fish and Parks: (May 20, 2026) intends to amend rules to modify Apprentice Deer Hunting, Youth Deer Hunting, and Mentored Youth Deer Hunting units in southeastern South Dakota. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the department, is SDCL [41-2-18](#) and [41-6-21](#).
