Brand Board Legislative Report for Calendar Year 2020

The South Dakota Brand Board operates on funds generated from the brand registration program and the brand inspection program. The Brand Board does not receive any general fund appropriations. **The registration and the use of brands apply to the entire state**. The livestock inspection area in South Dakota is west of the Missouri River. Any livestock leaving this inspection area must have a livestock ownership inspection or transportation permit prior to leaving. Livestock sold at livestock markets in western SD are brand inspected at the markets. When over five head of livestock are sold private treaty in western SD, a change of ownership inspection is required. Members of the Brand Board are appointed by the Governor and confirmed by the Senate. Brand Board members in 2020 were Bart Blum, Reliance; Scott Vance, Faith; Myron Williams, Wall; Lyle Spring, Union Center, and Dave Koupal, Edgemont. The Brand Board employees 11 full time brand inspectors, stationed at 10 livestock markets in western SD, 100 part-time/local brand inspectors and an office staff of seven which include the Director, Chief Brand Inspector, and a Brand Enforcement Officer/Livestock Investigator.

Livestock Inspections

In CY (calendar year) 2020 a total of 1,614,384 head of livestock were inspected. This is an increase of 29,349 head from 2019. A breakdown of inspections is the following: Livestock Markets – 1,078,570 head, Local Inspections – 528,819 head, Locker Plants – 6,312 head, Lifetime Horse Permits – 683 head. This compares with CY 2019 inspections of 1,585,035 head. The CY 2019 inspections are the following: Livestock Markets – 1,047,235 head, Local Inspections – 531,936 head, Locker Plants – 5,040 head, Lifetime Horse Permits – 824 head. Holds placed on livestock sales decreased in 2020 to 15,714 head compared with 17,400 head in 2019. Sixty-four holds were submitted to the Brand Board office to resolve ownership. Table 1 shows the inspections by month for each category. Table 2, which lists CY 2019 information, is included for comparison purposes. Some of the reported numbers are subject to change as data may be received in the brand office after the completion of this report.

Deposits for Inspection

Monthly inspection receipts, from fees collected at livestock markets and local inspections, are shown in Table 4. Fees collected for locker plants and feedlot inspections are included in the livestock market totals. As of July 1, 2013, the brand inspection fee is a \$1.00 per head plus mileage. The inspection receipts listed below do not include the mileage fees collected for local inspections. The brand inspectors are reimbursed the mileage fees. The CY 2019 fees are included for comparison purposes.

Missing or Stolen Livestock

The number of livestock reported missing or stolen in CY 20 <u>decreased</u> by 468 head as compared to CY 19. The head count and type of livestock, which were reported missing or stolen in CY 2020, are listed in Table 5. The numbers reported for CY 2019 are listed in Table 6. Some of the livestock reported missing or stolen may be the result of a civil dispute between producers, lenders taking possession of their security, or livestock may have died. Livestock which has been found or recovered may have been found by the owner, brand inspectors, livestock investigators or other law enforcement officials. **Producers who believe their livestock has been stolen should contact their local sheriff immediately**. The Brand Board works with other law enforcement agencies on missing/stolen livestock cases.

Recovered Strays

While conducting local brand inspections or inspecting livestock at livestock markets, strays are recovered by brand inspectors. Table 7 shows the number and type of livestock recovered during inspections completed for years 2016 thru 2020.

Brand Board Holds

A hold is placed on the sale proceeds if proof of ownership has not been established by the shipper of the livestock or the livestock was an estray. Prior to sending the proceeds to the Brand Board office, Brand inspectors attempt to resolve these holds for 60 days after date of the sale. Holds, which have been submitted to the Brand Board office, are shown below in Table 8. The number of holds implemented at the livestock markets, feedlots, locker plants and local inspections are included in Tables 1 and 2 on pages 2 and 3. If a hold was for an estray, the Chief Brand Inspector reviews grazing reports, missing livestock reports, obtains information from Animal Industry and from brand offices in surrounding states in an attempt to determine the owner. A detailed listing of Holds Received, Holds Paid, Pending, and Escheated to the Theft and Prevention Fund is included in the Appendix of this report. One hold in CY 20 was for 328 head which was the result of a civil dispute.

**Theft and Prevention Fund

Livestock Investigations

Legislation was passed in 2020 which gave the Brand Board authority to hire certified law enforcement officers for the enforcement of brand and brand inspection laws. Prior to 2020, livestock investigators were under the authority of the Attorney General's Office and supervised by the Division of Criminal Investigation (DCI). The Brand Board reimbursed the AG's office for the investigators' expenses. These reimbursements were paid out of the Brand Fund. During CY 20, the Brand Board's Chief Brand Inspector and the Brand Enforcement Officer/Investigator were both certified law enforcement officers.

Brand Program

The Brand Board office is also responsible for brand registrations, transfers, brand renewals, shipper permits, grazing permits, and trailing permits. Table 10 shows the main brand program revenue for 2020 and 2019. Brands are renewed every five years. Therefore, 2020 was a renewal year with the renewal period being January 1 - May 1, 2020. If a brand owner does not renew their brand by May 1st of the renewal year, the brand owner has two years to re-record their brand. Summary

The Brand Board strives to keep expenses to a minimum to operate the inspection program on a \$1.00/head plus mileage. Fees collected from the brand inspection program are used to operate the brand inspection program only. Although the number of livestock inspected in CY 20 increased by 29,329 head when compared to CY19, this is 47,211 head less than the 5-year average.

Total livestock reported missing or stolen for CY 20 was 682 head. This is a **468 head decrease** from CY19. If anyone believes their livestock has been stolen, they should contact local law enforcement immediately. The Brand Board's website <u>sdbrandboard.sd.gov</u> has a link to the SD Sheriff's Association which lists the Sheriffs' contact information. In CY 20, there were 213 head of livestock found/recovered of the livestock which had been reported as missing to the Brand Board. This is an increase of 102 head from CY 19. The Brand Board has seen an increase in the number of civil disputes regarding livestock ownership.

The Brand Board issues shipper permits, grazing permits, and trailing permits at no cost to the producers. Shipper permits allow producers to take their livestock out of the inspection area to an open market, without being inspected, as they will be inspected at the market. A grazing permit is issued to those producers who have imported cattle for grazing which branded with an out of state brand. If a pasture is divided by the state line, trailing permits may be issued to allow livestock to walk back and forth without a brand inspection.

New in 2020 was the option to renew brand registrations online by using credit/debits cards as forms of payment. The number of brand renewals paid by this method was 4,816 which is 20% of the brands renewed.

Revenue from brand renewals is what the Brand Board will use to operate the brand program on for 5 years. Additional revenue is generated from brand application fees and the brand registration transfer fee. The next brand renewal period is in 2025.
