

- Identified gaps and opportunities

- 16 small communities, population under 5,000
- Possible through matching grant of \$15,000

HIGH-IMPACT SITES


- Best sites for future development

- 596 Retained Childcare Slots







- Short-term: We continue to be on the forefront of significant growth in South Dakota. GOED will remain as nimble and flexible as possible to be able to adapt to a changing economic landscape.
- Mid-range: Broadband activity and small business lending will continue.
- Long-term: Broadband activity will begin tapering off in 3-5 years as many projects wrap up. Other programs expected to remain stable.
