Subgroup of the Offenses Regarding Controlled Substances Legislative Study.

"The subgroup would study the adequacy and effectiveness of South Dakota's prevention, intervention, and law enforcement efforts relating to the issue of methamphetamine addiction. The subgroup would also examine all state government resources currently devoted to fighting the methamphetamine addiction problem in the state to determine whether any of the state's efforts are duplicative, as well as which efforts are succeeding, and which are not. In addition, the subgroup would evaluate how the problem is being addressed on the local level and consider whether community support providers are able to adequately address the problem, and if not, how their efforts might be enhanced, or if there is a better approach. Finally, the subgroup would examine the availability and effectiveness of rehabilitation services at the state's prison and changes or enhancements that could be made. The subgroup would make recommendations to the legislature as a part of the report submitted by the legislative study created by SB167."
