## **AMENDMENT 24H FOR THE SENATE BILL**

1	An Act to allow a change of provide for voter registration information through ar

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4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
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6	Section 1. That a NEW SECTION be added:
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7	Online adjustment of voter registration.
8	A person eligible to vote under § 12-4-1, and who has a valid South Dakota driver license of
9	South Dakota nondriver identification card, may submit changes of last name, residence
10	address, mailing address, telephone number, email address, previous voter registration
11	information, party affiliation, and willingness to serve as an election worker for the purpose
12	of accurate voter registration records through an online electronic system maintained by the
13	Office of the Secretary of State. However, the initial voter registration process of an eligible
14	applicant may not be submitted through any online electronic system.
15	Section 1. That a NEW SECTION be added:

18	A person eligible to vote under § 12-4-1 and who has a valid South Dakota driver
19	license or South Dakota nondriver identification card may submit a voter registration form
20	electronically through an online electronic voter registration interface maintained by the
21	Office of the Secretary of State. The electronic voter registration interface shall perform
22	the following functions:

1	<u>(1)</u>	Validate that the applicant's information supplied as part of the voter registration		
2		process matches information contained in the driver license database maintained		
3		by the South Dakota Department of Public Safety;		
4	<u>(2)</u>	Authenticate the identity of any applicant under a process developed by the		
5		secretary of state that includes verifying the following information:		
6		(a) The applicant's driver license or nondriver identification card number;		
7		(b) The last five digits of the applicant's social security number;		
8		(c) The applicant's full name as printed on the applicant's driver license or		
9		nondriver identification card; and		
10		(d) The applicant's date of birth;		
11	<u>(3)</u>	Obtain an electronic copy of the applicant's signature from the applicant's driver		
12		license or nondriver identification card from the driver license database maintained		
13		by the Department of Public Safety. For voter registration purposes, the applicant		
14		is required to assent to the use of the applicant's signature from his or her driver		
15		license or nondriver identification card; and		
16	<u>(4)</u>	Transmit any completed and verified voter registration application to the statewide		
17		voter registration file.		
18		Any applicant for voter registration under this Act shall make a sworn written		
19	<u>state</u>	ment declaring and affirming, under the penalty of perjury, that the applicant is		
20	<u>entitl</u>	ed to register to vote under § 12-4-1 and that the applicant consents to providing		
21	the r	the requested information for the uses required under this section. This statement may		
22	<u>be m</u>	be made electronically as part of the process of utilizing the electronic voter registration		
23	interf	ace.		
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
