Senate Bill 64**AMENDMENT 64A FOR THE INTRODUCED BILL**

1 **An Act to make appropriations from the water and environment fund and its**
2 **revolving fund subfunds for various water and environmental purposes and**
3 **to declare an emergency.**

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

5 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the South Dakota water and environment fund
6 established pursuant to § 46A-1-60, the sum of \$1,021,500 to the Board of Water and Natural
7 Resources for the purpose of providing a grant to the Department of Agriculture and Natural
8 Resources for hydrology and water management studies to assess, model, and quantify the
9 state's surface water and groundwater resources. The specific activities to be funded include
10 drilling and development of new ground water observation wells in the Black Hills and Sioux
11 Falls regions where adequate information on the water resources of aquifers is unavailable.
12 Funds must be provided according to terms and conditions established by the Board of Water
13 and Natural Resources. Notwithstanding § 46A-1-61, the board may provide the grant for up
14 to one hundred percent of the nonfederal share of expenditures for hydrology and water
15 management studies.

16 **Section 2.** There is hereby appropriated from the South Dakota water and environment fund
17 established pursuant to § 46A-1-60, the sum of \$249,727 to the Board of Water and Natural
18 Resources for the purpose of providing a grant to the project sponsors to be used for the
19 feasibility level study update of the Big Sioux River flood control study of Watertown and its
20 vicinity, to be completed by the United States Army Corps of Engineers. Funds must be
21 provided according to terms and conditions established by the Board of Water and Natural
22 Resources.

23 **Section 3.** There is hereby appropriated from the South Dakota water and environment fund
24 established pursuant to § 46A-1-60, the sum of \$10,500,000 to the Board of Water and
25 Natural Resources for the purpose of providing grants and loans to project sponsors under

1 the consolidated water facilities construction program established pursuant to § 46A-1-63.1.
2 Funds must be provided according to terms and conditions established by the Board of Water
3 and Natural Resources.

4 **Section 4.** There is hereby appropriated from the South Dakota water and environment fund
5 established pursuant to § 46A-1-60, the sum of \$2,750,000 to the Board of Water and Natural
6 Resources for the purpose of providing grants and loans to project sponsors under the solid
7 waste management program established pursuant to § 46A-1-83. Funds must be provided
8 according to the terms and conditions established by the Board of Water and Natural
9 Resources.

10 **Section 5.** There is hereby appropriated from administrative expense surcharge fees
11 deposited in the South Dakota state water pollution control revolving fund program subfund
12 established pursuant to § 46A-1-60.1, the sum of \$300,000 to the Board of Water and Natural
13 Resources for the purpose of providing water quality grants under the state water pollution
14 control revolving fund program established pursuant to § 46A-1-60.1. Funds must be provided
15 according to terms and conditions established by the Board of Water and Natural Resources.

16 **Section 6.** There is hereby appropriated from administrative expense surcharge fees
17 deposited in the state water pollution control revolving fund program subfund established
18 pursuant to § 46A-1-60.1, the sum of \$250,000 to the Board of Water and Natural Resources
19 for the purpose of contracting for the preparation of applications and administration of clean
20 water state revolving fund loans under the state water pollution control revolving fund
21 program established pursuant to § 46A-1-60.1. Funds must be provided according to terms
22 and conditions established by the Board of Water and Natural Resources.

23 **Section 7.** There is hereby appropriated from administrative expense surcharge fees
24 deposited in the state drinking water revolving fund program subfund established pursuant
25 to § 46A-1-60.1, the sum of \$275,000 to the Board of Water and Natural Resources for the
26 purpose of contracting for the preparation of applications and administration of drinking water
27 state revolving fund loans under the state drinking water revolving fund program established
28 pursuant to § 46A-1-60.1. Funds must be provided according to terms and conditions
29 established by the Board of Water and Natural Resources.

30 **Section 8.** There is hereby appropriated from federal funds deposited in the state drinking
31 water revolving fund program subfund established pursuant to § 46A-1-60.1, the sum of
32 \$150,000 to the Board of Water and Natural Resources for the purpose of providing small

1 system technical assistance set-aside grants to project sponsors under the state drinking
2 water revolving fund program established pursuant to § 46A-1-60.1. Funds must be provided
3 according to terms and conditions established by the Board of Water and Natural Resources.

4 **Section 9.** There is hereby appropriated from federal funds deposited in the state drinking
5 water revolving fund subfund established pursuant to § 46A-1-60.1, the sum of \$1,500,000
6 to the Board of Water and Natural Resources for the purpose of contracting for a lead service
7 line inventory for all public water systems under the state drinking water revolving fund
8 program established pursuant to § 46A-1-60.1. Funds must be provided according to terms
9 and conditions established by the Board of Water and Natural Resources

10 **Section 10.** The secretary of the Department of Agriculture and Natural Resources shall
11 approve vouchers and the state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized
12 by this Act.

13 **Section 11.** Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated shall
14 revert in accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.

15 **Section 12.** Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its
16 existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in
17 full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
