AMENDMENT 104A FOR THE INTRODUCED BILL

## 1 An Act to modify certain provisions related to school district elections.

## 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

#### 3 Section 1. That § 13-7-11 be AMENDED:

**13-7-11.** The number and place of voting precincts <u>shall must</u> be determined by the school board.

A school board of a sparse school district, as defined in § 13-13-78, may not
designate fewer polling places than the number designated by a county commission within

8 <u>the school district's boundaries pursuant to § 12-14-1.</u>

#### 9 Section 2. That § 13-16-6.4 be AMENDED:

10 13-16-6.4. Approval to enter into an agreement or issue capital outlay certificates to which § 13-16-6.3 applies is subject to a referendum if five percent of the registered voters, based 11 12 upon the total number of registered voters at the last preceding general election, petition, 13 within twenty days thereafter, to have the question of approval or disapproval of the 14 agreement or issue of capital outlay certificates or the lease-purchase agreement placed upon 15 the ballot at the next regular election or at a special election called for that purpose. <u>The</u> 16 auestion may not be voted on until one hundred eighty days after the date of the public 17 hearing in § 13-16-6.3. The business manager shall give notice of the fact that the guestion will be on the ballot at a regular or special election as provided by law for school elections and 18 19 prepare official ballots therefor according to the provisions of this title relating to elections, 20 and the issue shall must be decided by sixty percent of those voting thereon.
