House Bill 1142**AMENDMENT 1142A FOR THE INTRODUCED BILL**

1 **An Act to exempt members of Indian tribes from admission fees, camping permit**
2 **fees, and park service fees of state parks and hunting and fishing license fees.**

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 **Section 1. That chapter 41-17 be amended with a NEW SECTION:**

5 A person who is an enrolled member of a federally recognized Indian tribe located
6 wholly or partially in the state, is exempt from admission fees, camping permit fees, and
7 park service fees of any state park.

8 **Section 2. That chapter 41-6 be amended with a NEW SECTION:**

9 A person who is an enrolled member of a federally recognized Indian tribe located
10 wholly or partially in the state, is exempt from paying any fee regarding the application
11 for, and obtainment of, a license, permit, or stamp classified in § 41-6-10.
