AMENDMENT 198D FOR THE HOUSE STATE AFFAIRS ENGROSSED BILL

1An Act to establish an interim committee regarding alternatives for the placement2of juvenile offenders.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

- Section 1. An interim juvenile placement committee is established to consider and develop 4 5 alternatives for the placement of juvenile offenders, develop findings, report on the findings, and recommend legislation. The speaker shall appoint five members of the House 6 7 Representatives and three members of the public, at least two with involvement in public 8 education. The president pro tempore shall appoint five members of the Senate and three 9 members of the public, at least two with involvement in public education. The Governor shall 10 appoint eight individuals. 11 The committee must consist of: (1) 12 Four members of the House of Representatives, appointed by the speaker of the House of Representatives; 13 14 (2)Four members of the Senate, appointed by the president pro tempore of the 15 Senate; Two administrators employed by school districts, appointed by the speaker of the 16 (3)
- 17 <u>House of Representatives;</u>
- 18 (4) Two administrators employed by school districts, appointed by the president pro
 19 tempore of the Senate;
- 20 (5) One mental health professional, appointed by the speaker of the House of
 21 <u>Representatives;</u>
- 22 (6) One mental health professional, appointed by the president pro tempore of the
 23 Senate;
- 24 (7) One addiction and prevention professional who provides services primarily to
 25 juveniles, appointed by the speaker of the House of Representatives;

1	(8) One addiction and prevention professional who provides services primarily to
2	juveniles, appointed by the president pro tempore of the Senate; and
3	(9) Three persons representing the South Dakota Unified Judicial System, appointed
4	by the Governor.
5	If there is a vacancy on the committee, the vacancy may be filled in the same
6	manner as the original appointment.
7	The committee shall be under the supervision of the Executive Board of the
8	Legislative Research Council and staffed and funded as an interim legislative committee.
9	The committee shall deliver its report and recommended legislation to the
10	Legislature by January 1, 2023.

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
