AMENDMENT 198E FOR THE HOUSE STATE AFFAIRS ENGROSSED BILL

1	An Act to establish an interim committee regarding alternatives for the placement	
2	of	juvenile offenders.
3	BE IT EN	ACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
4	Section :	1. An interim juvenile placement committee is established to consider and develop
5	<u>alternativ</u>	es for the placement of juvenile offenders, develop findings, report on the findings,
6	and reco	mmend legislation. The speaker shall appoint five members of the House of
7	Represen	tatives and three members of the public, at least two with involvement in public
8	<u>education</u>	. The president pro tempore shall appoint five members of the Senate and three
9	members	of the public, at least two with involvement in public education. The Governor shall
10	appoint e	ight individuals.
11		The committee must consist of:
12	(1)	Four members of the House of Representatives, appointed by the speaker of the
13		House of Representatives;
14	<u>(2)</u>	Four members of the Senate, appointed by the president pro tempore of the
15		Senate;
16	<u>(3)</u>	Two administrators employed by school districts, appointed by the speaker of the
17		House of Representatives;
18	<u>(4)</u>	Two administrators employed by school districts, appointed by the president pro
19		tempore of the Senate;
20	<u>(5)</u>	One mental health professional employed in the private sector, appointed by the
21		speaker of the House of Representatives;
22	<u>(6)</u>	One mental health professional employed in the private sector, appointed by the
23		president pro tempore of the Senate;
24	<u>(7)</u>	One addiction and prevention professional who is employed in the private sector
25		and provides services primarily to juveniles, appointed by the speaker of the House

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of Representatives;

1	<u>(8)</u>	One addiction and prevention professional who is employed in the private sector	
2		and provides services primarily to juveniles, appointed by the president pro	
3		tempore of the Senate;	
4	<u>(9)</u>	One person representing law enforcement, appointed by the speaker of the House	
5		of Representatives;	
6	(10)	One person representing law enforcement, appointed by the president pro tempore	
7		of the Senate; and	
8	<u>(9)</u>	Two persons representing the South Dakota Unified Judicial System, appointed by	
9		the Chief Justice of the South Dakota Supreme Court.	
10		If there is a vacancy on the committee, the vacancy may be filled in the same	
11	mann	er as the original appointment.	
12		The committee shall be under the supervision of the Executive Board of the	
13	Legisl	Legislative Research Council and staffed and funded as an interim legislative committee.	
14		The committee shall deliver its report and recommended legislation to the	
15	Legisl	ature by January 1, 2023.
