AMENDMENT 16A FOR THE INTRODUCED BILL

- An Act to make appropriations for water and environmental purposes and to declare an emergency.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 46A-1-2.1 be AMENDED:

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- 46A-1-2.1. The Legislature finds that the following water resources projects are necessary for the general welfare of the people of this state and authorizes the projects, pursuant to § 46A-1-2, to be included in the state water resources management system, to serve as the preferred, priority objectives of the state:
 - (1) Belle Fourche irrigation upgrade project;
- 10 (2) Big Sioux flood control study;
- 11 (3) Hydrology and water management studies, to manage and protect state water 12 resources for current and future generations;
- 13 (4) Cendak irrigation project;
- 14 (5) <u>Dakota Mainstem regional water system study;</u>
- 15 <u>(6) Gregory County pumped storage site;</u>
- 16 (6)(7) Lake Andes-Wagner/Marty II irrigation unit;
- 17 (7)(8) Lewis and Clark rural water system;
- 18 (8)(9) Sioux Falls flood control project;
- 19 (9)(10) Vermillion basin flood control project;
- 20 (10)(11) Water Investment in Northern South Dakota project; and
- 21 (11)(12) Western Dakota Regional Water System study.
- 22 **Section 2.** There is hereby appropriated from the South Dakota water and environment fund
- 23 the sum of \$1,000,000, in other fund expenditure authority, to the Board of Water and Natural
- 24 Resources for the purpose of providing a grant to local project sponsors for a feasibility-level

- 3 Moneys must be provided according to the terms and conditions established by the Board of
- 4 <u>Water and Natural Resources.</u>
- 5 **Section 3.** There is hereby appropriated from the South Dakota water and environment fund
- 6 the sum of \$5,000,000, in other fund expenditure authority, to the Board of Water and Natural
- 7 Resources for the purpose of providing a grant to local project sponsors for the engineering
- 8 <u>design, preconstruction activities, and construction of the facilities included in the Water</u>
- 9 <u>Investment in Northern South Dakota project.</u>
- 10 Moneys must be provided according to the terms and conditions established by the Board of
- 11 Water and Natural Resources.
- 12 **Section 4.** There is hereby appropriated from the South Dakota water and environment fund
- the sum of \$1,000,000, in other fund expenditure authority, to the Board of Water and Natural
- 14 Resources for the purpose of providing a grant to local project sponsors for a feasibility-level
- 15 <u>study, system startup, and administration of the Western Dakota regional water system</u>
- 16 study.
- 17 Moneys must be provided according to the terms and conditions established by the Board of
- 18 Water and Natural Resources.
- 19 **Section 5.** There is hereby appropriated from the South Dakota water and environment fund
- 20 the sum of \$4,600,000, in other fund expenditure authority, to the Board of Water and Natural
- 21 Resources for the purpose of providing grants and loans to project sponsors under the state
- 22 consolidated water facilities construction program, established pursuant to § 46A-1-63.1.
- 23 Moneys must be provided according to the terms and conditions established by the Board of
- 24 <u>Water and Natural Resources.</u>
- 25 **Section 6.** There is hereby appropriated from the South Dakota water and environment fund
- the sum of \$2,500,000, in other fund expenditure authority, to the Board of Water and Natural
- 27 Resources for the purpose of providing grants and loans to project sponsors under the state
- 28 <u>solid waste management program, established pursuant to § 46A-1-83.</u>

- 3 **Section 7.** There is hereby appropriated from administrative expense surcharge fees
- 4 deposited in the state water pollution control revolving fund program subfund the sum of
- 5 \$2,200,000, in other fund expenditure authority, to the Board of Water and Natural Resources
- 6 for the purpose of providing water quality grants under the state water pollution control
- 7 revolving fund program, established pursuant to § 46A-1-60.1.
- 8 Moneys must be provided according to the terms and conditions established by the Board of
- 9 Water and Natural Resources.
- 10 **Section 8.** There is hereby appropriated from administrative expense surcharge fees
- deposited in the state drinking water revolving fund program subfund the sum of \$2,000,000,
- 12 <u>in other fund expenditure authority, to the Board of Water and Natural Resources for the</u>
- 13 purpose of providing grants for the construction of drinking water facilities under the state
- 14 drinking water revolving fund program, established pursuant to § 46A-1-60.1.
- 15 Moneys must be provided according to the terms and conditions established by the Board of
- 16 Water and Natural Resources.
- 17 **Section 9.** There is hereby appropriated from administrative expense surcharge fees
- deposited in the state water pollution control revolving fund program subfund the sum of
- 19 \$500,000, in other fund expenditure authority, to the Board of Water and Natural Resources
- 20 for the purpose of contracting for the preparation of applications and the administration of
- 21 <u>clean water state revolving fund loans under the state water pollution control revolving fund</u>
- 22 program, established pursuant to § 46A-1-60.1.
- 23 Moneys must be provided according to the terms and conditions established by the Board of
- 24 Water and Natural Resources.
- 25 **Section 10.** There is hereby appropriated from administrative expense surcharge fees
- deposited in the state drinking water revolving fund program subfund the sum of \$500,000,
- 27 in other fund expenditure authority, to the Board of Water and Natural Resources for the
- 28 <u>purpose of contracting for the preparation of applications and the administration of drinking</u>
- 29 water state revolving fund loans under the state drinking water revolving fund program,
- 30 established pursuant to § 46A-1-60.1.

1 Moneys must be provided according to the terms and conditions established by the Board of

- 2 Water and Natural Resources.
- 3 **Section 11.** There is hereby appropriated from federal funds deposited in the state drinking
- 4 <u>water revolving fund program subfund the sum of \$300,000, in federal fund expenditure</u>
- 5 <u>authority, to the Board of Water and Natural Resources for the purpose of providing small</u>
- 6 system technical assistance and local assistance set-aside grants, or contracts, to eligible
- 7 entities under the state drinking water revolving fund program, established pursuant to §
- 8 <u>46A-1-60.1.</u>
- 9 Moneys must be provided according to the terms and conditions established by the Board of
- 10 Water and Natural Resources.
- 11 **Section 12.** There is hereby appropriated from federal funds deposited in the state water
- 12 pollution control revolving fund program subfund the sum of \$200,000, in federal fund
- 13 expenditure authority, to the Board of Water and Natural Resources for the purpose of
- 14 providing small system technical assistance set-aside grants, or contracts, to eligible entities
- 15 under the state water pollution control revolving fund program, established pursuant to §
- 16 <u>46A-1-60.1.</u>
- 17 Moneys must be provided according to the terms and conditions established by the Board of
- 18 Water and Natural Resources.
- 19 **Section 13.** The secretary of the Department of Agriculture and Natural Resources shall
- 20 approve vouchers and the state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized
- 21 by this Act.
- 22 **Section 14.** Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated shall
- 23 revert in accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.
- 24 **Section 15.** Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its
- 25 existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in
- 26 full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
