AMENDMENT 1259B FOR THE HOUSE STATE AFFAIRS ENGROSSED BILL

An Act to prohibit unauthorized access to certain multi-occupancy rooms and to provide a penalty therefor.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

5 Section 1. That a NEW SECTION be added to chapter 13-32:

6		Terms used in sections 1 to 5, inclusive of this Act mean:
7	<u>(1)</u>	"Changing room," a room or area in which an individual may be in a state of
8		undress in the presence of others, including a multi-occupancy locker room or
9		shower room;
10	<u>(2)</u>	"Female," an individual who naturally has, had, will have, or would have, but for a
11		congenital anomaly or intentional or unintentional disruption, the reproductive
12		system that produces, transports, and utilizes eggs for fertilization;
13	<u>(3)</u>	"Male," an individual who naturally has, had, will have, or would have, but for a
14		congenital anomaly or intentional or unintentional disruption, the reproductive
15		system that produces, transports, and utilizes sperm for fertilization;
16	<u>(4)</u>	"Public school," a school under the authority of the board of a school district;
17	<u>(5)</u>	"Reasonable accommodation," access to:
18		(a) A unisex or family room; or
19		(b) A single-occupancy changing room or restroom which has been designated
20		for employees of the district, provided the room is not available to the
21		employees while being used by the student; and
22	<u>(6)</u>	"Restroom," a room that includes one or more toilets or urinals;
23	<u>(7)</u>	"Sleeping quarters," a room that contains a bed and in which more than one
24		individual is housed overnight;
25	<u>(8)</u>	"Sex," an individual's biological sex, either male or female; and

26 (9) "Unisex or family room," a changing room or restroom that:

1	(a) Is intended for use by a single occupant, a single occupant and the
2	occupant's caregiver, or members of the same family;
3	(b) Is enclosed by means of floor-to-ceiling walls; and
4	(c) Is accessible by means of a full door, with a secure lock that prevents entry
5	by another individual while the room is in use.
6	Section 2. That a NEW SECTION be added to chapter 13-32:
7	A public school must designate any multi-occupancy changing room, restroom, or
8	sleeping quarters rented by the public school for use exclusively by females or for use
9	exclusively by males.
10	If a public school student participates in a school or school district sponsored or
11	sanctioned activity occurring at a location other than the school in which the student is
12	enrolled, the school must ensure that any multi-occupancy changing room, restroom, or
13	sleeping quarters, located at the site of the activity and available to the student, is
14	designated for use exclusively by females or for use exclusively by males.
15	If any student is unable or unwilling to use a multi-occupancy changing room,
16	restroom, or sleeping quarters, in accordance with the designation set forth in this section,
17	and the student, or the student's parent in the case of a student under the age of eighteen,
18	files a written notice with the administrator of the school, the administrator may grant a
19	request for a reasonable accommodation.
20	A reasonable accommodation granted under this section must be for a stated
21	period of time and may not:
22	(1) Exceed the conclusion of the school year; or
23	(2) Include access to a facility designated for use exclusively by members of the
24	opposite sex.

25	Section 3. That a NEW SECTION be added to chapter 13-32:
26	<u>A male may not enter a changing room, or restroom, or sleeping quarters</u>
27	designated exclusively for females.
28	A female may not enter a changing room, or restroom, or shower room designated
29	exclusively for males.
30	A public school must take reasonable steps to provide individuals with privacy in
31	changing rooms, restrooms, and sleeping quarters for members of the opposite sex by
32	designating each as available for use exclusively by female students or for use exclusively
33	by male students.

1	Section 7. That a NEW SECTION be added to chapter 20-13:		
2	Except as otherwise provided in sections 2 and 3 of this Act, any multi-occupancy		
3	changing room, restroom, or shower room sleeping quarters in a building or facility owned		
4	or leased by the state or by a political subdivision of this state must be designated for t		
5	exclusive use of females or males.		
6	Section 8. That a NEW SECTION be added to chapter 20-13:		
7	Except as otherwise provided in section 9 of this Act, a male may not enter a		
8	changing room or restroom designated exclusively for females.		
9	Except as otherwise provided in section 9 of this Act, a female may not enter a		
10	changing room or restroom designated exclusively for males.		
11	The state or a political subdivision shall take reasonable steps to provide an		
12	individual with privacy from a member of the opposite sex, in restrooms-and, changing		
13	rooms, and sleeping quarters in any building or facility owned or operated by the state or		
14	the political subdivision.		
15	An individual who encounters a member of the opposite sex in a restroom or		
16	changing room while making use of a restroom or changing room designated for use by		
17	the individual's sex, has a private cause of action for declaratory and injunctive relief		
18	against the state or political subdivision that:		
19	(1) Provided the member of the opposite sex permission to use the restroom or		
20	changing room of the individual's sex; or		
21	(2) Failed to take reasonable steps to prohibit the member of the opposite sex from		
22	using the restroom or changing room of the individual's sex.		
23	An individual who is assigned by the state or a political subdivision to share sleeping		
24	quarters with an individual of the opposite sex has a private cause of action for declaratory		
25	and injunctive relief against the state or political subdivision.		
26	Any civil action brought pursuant to this section must be initiated within two years		
27	of the violation. An individual who is aggrieved under this section and prevails in court		
28	may recover reasonable attorney fees and costs from the state or offending political		
29	subdivision.		
30	Section 9. That a NEW SECTION be added to chapter 20-13:		

The prohibitions set forth in section 8 of this Act do not apply to: 31

1	<u>(1)</u>	An individual who accompanies a child under the age of ten, if the individual is the
2		child's parent or lawful chaperone;
3	<u>(2)</u>	An individual who accompanies another individual requiring assistance because of
4		age or a disability;
5	<u>(3)</u>	A law enforcement officer or fire official acting in an official capacity;
6	<u>(4)</u>	An individual providing emergency medical assistance; or
7	<u>(5)</u>	An individual providing custodial, maintenance, or inspection services, provided the
8		<u>changing room, or restroom, or shower room</u> is unoccupied.
