Senate Bill 152**AMENDMENT 152A
FOR THE INTRODUCED BILL**

This bill has been extensively amended (hoghoused) and may no longer be consistent with the original intention of the sponsor.

1 **An Act to ~~promote the future success and development of South Dakota~~reduce the**
2 **state's contribution to a subsidized high school dual credit program.**

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 **Section 1. That § 13-28-37.1 be AMENDED:**

5 **13-28-37.1.** A state subsidized high school dual credit program must be
6 established for any student in ~~grades~~ grade eleven or twelve. The public institution of
7 higher education or technical college offering the credit shall set the admission standards.
8 A participating institution shall regularly submit course availability, enrollment, and
9 completion data to the Department of Education.

10 If a student receives a failing grade in any course or withdraws from a course after
11 the deadline and does not receive credit for the course, the student may no longer
12 participate in the program. The Board of Regents or the South Dakota Board of Technical
13 Education may reinstate a student who is prohibited from participating in the dual credit
14 program, if the student demonstrates good cause for failing a course or withdrawing from
15 a course, or if, at the student's expense, the student retakes and passes the course that
16 the student withdrew from or failed.

17 The dual credit program may not be used for remedial courses.

18 The Board of Regents shall set a high school dual credit tuition rate equivalent to
19 forty-three percent of the undergraduate tuition rate. The student taking the course shall
20 pay an amount equal to ~~thirty-three and three-tenths~~ fifty percent of the total high school
21 dual credit tuition rate ~~and a school district may pay any portion of the student's share.~~
22 The state shall pay an amount equal to ~~sixty-six and seven-tenths~~ fifty percent of the total
23 high school dual credit tuition rate. The board of a school district may establish a policy
24 to pay any portion of the student's share of the cost of the dual credit course. No public

1 institution of higher education or technical college offering the credit may require any
2 additional fees.

3 The student is responsible for any other costs involved with attending a
4 postsecondary institution.

5 For the purposes of this section, ~~the term, undergraduate tuition rate,~~
6 "undergraduate tuition rate" means the per-credit rate, as set by the Board of Regents,
7 that was in effect on January first of the previous fiscal year.
